Can a male dog go into heat?

According to the [American Kennel Club](#), male dogs don't go into heat; instead, they're capable of mating year-round once they become fertile at about 6 months old. ... While in heat, a female dog is especially attractive to male dogs and will experience a swollen vulva, vaginal bleeding and more frequent urination.

While frequency varies according to breed and individual dogs, usually dogs go into heat about twice a year or every six months. Each estrus period lasts about 18 days. Male dogs will be attracted to a female dog for the full 18 days, but the female dog will only be receptive to males for about half that time.

Can I register my dog with AKC without papers?

With the American Kennel Club, you are unable to register a puppy without the required papers. These can be gained from the breeder if both of the parents are AKC registered. You will be unable to permanently register your dog with the United Kennel Club without their papers.

What is the difference between AKC and NKC?

There are many registries of dogs in the United States. ... The difference between AKC and NKC is that the American Kennel Club or the AKC registers only the pure breed of dogs whereas the National Kennel Club or the NKC registers all breeds of dogs.
