Can I use nail polish remover instead of rubbing alcohol?

Acetone will dissolve many things that isopropyl will not. ... Acetone/nail polish remover It is usually made with isopropyl alcohol, but it is different because its acetone properties makes it a solvent. Rubbing alcohol's molecular structure, similar to ethanol, does not allow it to dissolve plastic or nail polish.

Acetone (C₃H₆O) has a pH of 7, which means that the substance, on its own, is neither an acid nor a base. This pH value, which is about the same as pure water, shows that acetone is relatively neutral.

Is acetone an acid?

Relatively speaking, acetone is a very, very weak acid (as User mentioned, it's even weaker than water!) but still an acid nonetheless.

What type of drug is nail polish remover?
