# MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

## Can Pell grant be used for off campus housing?

Pell Grants can work like housing scholarships that cover a meal plan and room costs. Students living on campus typically apply their Pell Grant to dorm expenses. ... If the school manages off-campus apartments as part of Residential Life, then Pell grants for room and board are allowable.

### How much does fafsa give you for off campus housing?

For example: In 2017, off-campus students received a standard \$10,563 for housing expenses for the academic year (nine months), while on-campus students received up to \$15,425.

# Does fafsa check if you live off campus?

Impact on Financial Aid Eligibility Living off-campus does not affect a student's financial aid eligibility. A standard room and meals amount is used to determine undergraduate students' cost of attendance whether they live on- or off-campus. The amount for the 2020-2021 school year is approximately \$15,984.

#### Does fafsa cover rent?

If a student's financial aid package amounts to more than tuition, fees and any other billable expenses, he or she typically receives a refund for the remaining amount. That money, typically disbursed at the beginning of the semester, can go toward rent, bills, food and other off-campus necessities.

#### What is the income limit for Pell Grant 2020?

If your family makes less than \$30,000 a year, you likely will qualify for a good amount of Pell Grant funding. If your family makes between \$30,000 and \$60,000 per year, you can qualify for some funding, but likely not the full amount.

#### Why am I not eligible for a Pell Grant?

If your EFC is at or below \$5,711 for the 2020-21 academic year, you will be eligible to receive the Pell Grant. Each family's financial situation is different, and there's no one income cutoff that makes a student eligible or ineligible to receive the Pell.

### How do you qualify for a federal Pell Grant?

In general, you must maintain enrollment in an undergraduate course of study at a nonforeign school to receive a Federal Pell Grant. Additionally, you will have to fill out the FAFSA form every year you're in school in order to stay eligible for federal student aid.

### How do poor students pay for college?

The most common for low income students is the Pell Grant, which offers up to \$5,775 to eligible students for the 2015-2016 academic year. Another is the Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, which provides between \$100 and \$4,000 per year.

### How long can you get fafsa loans?

Please note that you can receive the Federal Pell Grant for no more than 12 terms or the equivalent (roughly six years). You'll receive a notice if you're getting close to your limit. If you have any questions, contact your financial aid office.

#### What is the maximum Pell Grant a student can receive?

The maximum Federal Pell Grant for 2020–21 (July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021) will be \$6,345. The amount an individual student may receive depends on a number of factors.

# Can I get the Pell Grant every year?

The fast answer is that you're entitled to receive financial aid in the form of Pell Grants for the equivalent of six years (or 12 semesters). During that time, you're eligible to receive the maximum amount of Pell Grant aid that you qualify for every year.

### How many semesters does fafsa cover?

The Federal Pell Grant is awarded to undergraduate students for up to 12 semesters of eligibility. How Many Years can You Get Federal Work-Study?

# Do you get fafsa money every semester?

If you qualify for a Federal Pell Grant, your total award for the year will be split between semesters during each school year. For example, if you're eligible for \$3,000, you will receive \$1,500 for fall semester an \$1,500 for spring semester.

# Can I still receive financial aid after I graduate?

Once you have earned a bachelor's degree or your first professional degree, or you've used up all 12 semesters of your eligibility, you are no longer eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant.










































