# MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

## Can you flip summon a special summoned monster?

With the new ruling, you can then immediately flip it face up due to it being a special summon. Just because it's a Special Summon doesn't make it any more privileged than anything else. It was still summoned this turn, so its battle position cannot be changed.

## Can you flip summon on your opponent's turn?

You cannot perform a Flip Summon during your opponent's turn. A Flip Summon is a way of manually changing the monster's Battle Position. Since it is "manual", it can only be done during your own Main Phase.

# Do flip summons count for summon limit?

Previously Official Rulings They were previously considered official and can still be correct, as long as they follow the official gameplay rules, or unless Konami has issued a ruling that says otherwise. References: The limit applied by "Summon Limit" includes Normal Summons, Flip Summons, and Special Summons.

#### Is a tribute summon a normal summon?

A Tribute Summon is treated exactly as Normal Summon, except a few cards refer specifically to whether or not the card was Tribute Summoned (such as Monarchs). Normally only one Tribute Summon can be conducted in the same turn (exceptions: see "Ultimate Offering" and "Double Summon").

# Can you flip summon and attack?

Flip Summon does not take up your Normal Summon/Set for the turn. You cannot Flip Summon a monster at the same turn it was Summoned, Normal Set, declared an attack (even if the attack was negated or canceled), or its battle position was changed manually that turn.

### Is a set a normal summon?


Set To play a Monster Card from your hand in face-down Defense Position is called a Set. ... It has been Set and can be Summoned with a Flip Summon or flipped face-up by an attack or card effect. Remember, you can only Normal Summon OR Set once per turn, so if you Set a monster you cannot Normal Summon a monster that turn.

## Does flip summon count as a summon?

1 Answer. A flip summon does not count as a normal summon. For this effect to activate you would have to summon it from your hand in face up attack position (a normal summon as stated).


### Is Tribute summon a normal summon?




