Do the Amish have dietary restrictions?

Although no foods are prohibited in the Amish culture, alcohol consumption is strongly discouraged (1,2).

What do Amish eat and drink?

Some of this might be attributable to the Amish diet, which is heavy on pancakes, eggs and sausage for breakfast; and meat, potatoes, gravy and bread for dinner. Working the farm can burn off those calories, but all the fat and salt and carbs still take a toll.

Do Amish people drink?

The Amish eschew modern technology and try to live as close to a simple, biblical life as possible. ... It is a rare occurrence as Amish do not drink alcohol as a rule, but one Amish boy was stopped by police when he attempted to engage in a chase with a police car after he had drunk a beer.
