
What is the name of high school diploma?

GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT (GED) The GED is a battery of tests, based on courses and/or guided self-study, that when passed result in the award of a certificate that is recognized in the United States as the legal equivalent of a high school diploma.

How should your name appear on a certificate?

Generally you can choose how you want your name displayed on a certificate. However, it is customary to have at least your first name and family name spelled in full. Any other names can be substituted with just the first letter.
