How can I make my Converse tighter?

Grab the lace coming out of the side of your shoe and put it into the second side hole. Then, grab it from the inside of your shoe and pull it tight. Lacing your laces through the side hole can actually make your Converse tighter and fit better.

RELATED QUESTIONS

Will my Converse shrink in the dryer?

Tennis shoes. As long as they're not high-performance sneaks, you can totally toss your Converse in. ... Your shoes probably won't be damaged if you occasionally put them in the dryer. However, the fabric and soles of the shoes will shrink or warp the more you machine dry them.


How do you shrink shoes that are too big?

If you have leather shoes that fit a bit lose, what you need to shrink them is a bit of water in a spray bottle and your trusty blow dryer. Once you have your shrinking items, spray your shoes generously but don't soak them. Afterward, simply dry your shoe with the blow dryer set in medium.

Do Converse still run big?

In general, Converse fit bigger than your average shoe. On their site, the brand states that Converse fit a half size bigger but some people say to go down a full size, especially if you wear a larger size to start with. A great way to find your Converse size is by manually measuring your foot.
