MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

How do I ship to a PO box?

When shipping to a PO box, it is important to remember that the address specified must be the PO Box address and not the street address. As with any shipment, the first and last names of the recipient need to be specified, together with the company's name (if needed), the city and the country.

Can you put a PO box and street address on an envelope?

If you have a PO Box and a street address, you can decide which one the USPS will deliver your mail to, simply by putting your preferred delivery location on the first address line.

Can I drop off a letter to a PO box?

Can I drop a letter in a PO box? Yes, you can send USPS Certified Mail to a P.O. Box in the United States. USPS Certified Mail letters are addressed and delivered to the PO Box with no changes in mailers process. In other words you just address the letter using the PO Box instead of the street delivery address.








