# How do you wish Happy New Year in Chinese?

"Gong hei fat choy" is the most common Chinese New Year greeting in Cantonese, which is spoken in parts of southern China and Hong Kong. It directly translates to "wishing you great happiness and prosperity." In Mandarin, the same greeting is "gong xi fa cai" (pronounced gong she fa tsai).

# What does NI HAO mean in English?

The first character 你 (nǐ) means "you." The second character 好 (hǎo) means "good". Thus, the literal translation of 你 好 (nǐ hǎo) is "you good".

Honours are awarded at New Year and on the monarch's "official birthday". ... The higher honours confer noble titles: "Sir" and "Dame" in the case of knighthoods; "Lord" and "Baron" or "Lady" and "Baroness" in the case of life peerages; and one of the ranks of the hereditary nobility in the case of hereditary peerages.
