How do you feel music?


What does How's it feel mean?

The sentence means "how does it feel?" This is, by the way, not an accepted abbreviation of does. However, the book is transcribing the way many of us speak. In casual AE it is very common to say "How's it feel?" instead of "How does it feel." I would use this abbreviation in your own writing when transcribing dialog.

How does it feel dance?

"Dancing stimulates us physically and emotionally while there are also cognitive and social elements to it," he explains. "You appear to get a much bigger release of endorphins when you dance than during other forms of exercise; it also connects with the emotional centres in the brain.
