The standard response in English to 'Christ is risen' is 'He is risen indeed'.

RELATED QUESTIONS

What does Christos Voskrese mean?

It goes as follows: Hristos voskrese (Христос воскресе), meaning "Christ is risen". The proper response is: Voistina voskrese (Воистина воскресе), "Truly, He is risen".

How do you say Christ is risen in Arabic?

A traditional exchange of greetings between Christians on Easter runs as follows: Christ is risen! ĀalmaSiH qām!

What is the Greek Easter greeting?

HARPERSVILLE — "Christos Anesti" or "Christ is risen" is a traditional greeting among Greek Orthodox Christians during their Pascha, or Easter service. "One person says 'Christos Anesti! ' or 'Christ is risen! ' and the person with the other egg responds with 'Alithos Anesti!
