How do you say D in Danish?

There are many different ways that the letter D is pronounced in Danish. An easy pronunciation rule for D is that when it appears after N or L, it's silent. So words like hand (hand) and kold (cold) end up sounding more like [hon] and [kol].

Is Danish hard to pronounce?

To learn spoken Danish is not something you will do perfect unless it is a mother-tongue from childhood. You can get very close, but the depths of weird pronunciation and details in regional dialect is completely excessive to the size and relevance of the language.
