MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

How do you take care of a hyacinth in a vase after flowering?

After the blooms have started to fade and die for the year, cut them away. Leave the leaves behind, as these are essential for storing moisture and nutrients. Continue to water the bulb as usual and wait for the leaves to start to brown. This step can occur after several days or even several weeks.

So, it's important to actually NOT cut the stems of your hyacinth flowers, but instead, simply wash off any soil that you may find on them and put them in a clean vase of water and enjoy!

What do you do with hyacinth bulbs after they bloom?

After your hyacinths have finished flowering, snip off the flower stalks, but don't remove the foliage. The bulbs need their leaves to gather energy for next year's blooms. At the end of the spring season, the foliage will die back naturally, at which point it can be removed.








