When you drive your car through the bank drive-thru lane, there will be a designated spot for you to stop, known as the station. This is the area where you will be able to communicate with your bank teller through a speaker, similar to a fast-food drive-thru.

What was the first bank in the world?


Depending on the definition, the world's oldest bank is either Banca Monte dei Paschi di Siena or Berenberg Bank. Banca Monte dei Paschi di Siena was founded in its present form in 1624, but traces its history to a mount of piety founded in 1472.

How much money can you withdraw from bank drive thru?

Yes. Members can withdraw \$1,500 in cash in a 24-hour period and up to five checks in a 24-hour period. **How do I withdraw money from drive thru teller?**

If you are withdrawing or transferring from your account, you will need to fill out a drive-thru slip. These slips are located in the receptacle in the drive-thru line as you pull into the drive-thru. Use the tube system to give your completed slip to the representative to complete your transaction.
