What does the K stand for in money?

When talking about money, the letter K after a number denotes thousands. 1K means \$1,000 while 100K stands for \$100,000.

What does K stand for in money?

K is short for kilo, which means (in base 10) one thousand. However K can also stand for kilobit or kilobyte, in which case it stands for 2 to the power of 10, or 1024. The alphabet "K" is used as an abbreviation of Kilo which means 1000. So 1K or 1k means 1000/- or.

What is 25k in money?

25k means 25,000. People who work in the capital markets don't usually use "k." They use "m" for thousands and "mm" for millions. So, if one were talking about \$25,000, it would be abbreviated as \$25m.
