MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

How high is a 5 story building?

Under the current standard a 5 story building can be at most 75 feet tall. That is an average of 15 feet per story. Also under the current standard, a 4 story building can be at most 62 feet or an average of 15.5 feet per story.

RELATED QUESTIONS

How high is a 17 story building?

Officials have tossed around "17 stories" as an estimate, though, meaning the slide could be upwards of 170 feet tall or more (building stories tend to measure between 10 to 15 feet tall).


How high is a 10 story building?

Typical floor thickness is 6 inches. So for 10 floors, add another 10x6 inches = 60/12 = 5 feet. Therefore, Total height of a 10 story building = 100 to 110 feet.

How high is a 30 story building?

Every 30 stories there is a mechanical floor of 4.65 m high and the roof mechanical level is estimated at 6.2 m high. As a result, a residential tower approximately 100 m tall has 30 usable stories $[4.65m + (30 \times 3.1m) + 4.65m + 6.2 m = 108.5m]$ (Fig. 3a).
