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# How long does a texturizer last on natural hair?

The amount of time the chemicals are left to react with the hair is the main factor in differing results between the two processes. Texturizers shouldn't be left on for more than five to 10 minutes. This time factor is also what can make it difficult to get uniform results from one texturizer to the next.

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### Is a texturizer good for natural hair?

Texturizers allow you to keep your natural curl pattern in a looser form. For some hair textures, this can create bouncy curls while others may get beautiful waves. Texturizers can make straightening the hair easier if that's your goal, though it will not produce bone straight results like the relaxing process.


# How long does Comb Thru Texturizer last?

You should only leave a texturizer on the hair for about five to 10 minutes. This allows the chemicals to loosen the curl. The effects of the texturizer last permanently, but you'll have to treat your hair's new growth to loosen incoming curls as your hair grows.

## Does a texturizer damage your hair?

"Texturizers are less potent than traditional relaxers, so in theory, they are less damaging to the hair. Most texturizer products include a few key ingredients to help condition and restore the hair. However, it is important to remember that a chemical treatment, no matter how 'lite' is still a chemical treatment.





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
