How Long Does It Take Roofing Cement to Dry? Drying time varies depending on materials and weather conditions, but the average drying time is 12 hours. For a complete cure, allow 24 hours.

Does Tar dry completely?

Though the application of the tar doesn't take a long time, the drying or curing period certainly does. ... Yes, tar can be applied to a roof in temperatures as low as 40 degrees Fahrenheit. However it won't properly dry and seal until the temperature is at least 70 degrees.

Does roofing tar get hard?

If it's exposed to the sun it will harden and crack eventually, how long depends on which brand and how it's applied. If it is good quality plastic cement/tar and sandwiched between something away from the sun it could remain pliable and sticky for 20+ yrs depending on the brand. Def Exposed to the Sun.

How long does Tar last on a roof?

A built-up tar and gravel roof has an average lifespan of 20 to 25 years. You may notice that a tar and gravel roof is installed on many low slope or flat roof commercial buildings.
