A heptagon is defined as polygon with seven angles and seven sides. The heptagon is sometimes referred to as the septagon, using the Latin numerical prefix "sept" rather than the Greek numerical prefix "hepta." In a regular heptagon, one in which all sides and angles are equal to each other, each interior angle is equal to approximately 128.57 degrees, with the sum of all interior angles being equal to 900 degrees.


