# **MORE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

### How many months of the year have at least 28 days?

All 12 months in a year have 28 days. Go through the calendar; you will find 28th January, 28th February, 28th March, 28th April, 28th May, 28th June, 28th July, 28th August, 28th September, 28th October, 28th November and 28th December - regardless of leap year.

#### How many days are in 2008?

2008 is a leap year, so there are 366 days in the year.

### How many months have a total of 30 days?

30 days has September, April, June and November. And 29 in each leap year.

### How long is a whole month?

The mean length of the synodic month is 29.53059 days (29 days, 12 hours, 44 minutes, 2.8 seconds). Due to the eccentricity of the lunar orbit around Earth (and to a lesser degree, the Earth's elliptical orbit around the Sun), the length of a synodic month can vary by up to seven hours.


## How many different months have exactly thirty days?

30 days has September, April, June and November. And 29 in each leap year.

#### Why do some months have 31 30 29 or 28 days?

The ancient Romans, like ancient civilizations before them, based their concept of the month on the Moon. ... Julius Caesar modified the Roman calendar in 46 B.C. to make each month have either 30 or 31 days, with the exception of Februarius, which had 29 days and gained an extra day every fourth year.
