How much does it cost to fix a gas leak in a house?

Here's an idea of what you can expect to pay for various repairs: Repairing or replacing a gas line to a single appliance usually costs anywhere from about \$150 to \$650. That includes labor and materials. Replacing the gas line running to the house costs \$3,000 to \$7,000 in most cases (labor and materials).

How long does it take for gas to clear out of house?

My wife did this recently in my house too, after I had rerouted several gas lines while installing a new stove. I'd open as many windows in the house as I could, but as morroben says, 2 hours is more than enough time for it to dissipate. If your stove has an extractor fan, run that for a while too just to be 100% sure.

How long does it take to clear a gas leak?

The smell should dissipate within a few hours. If it doesn't, contact your gas company and report the problem – there may be a more extensive leak. If anyone is suffering from nausea, headaches, dizziness or flu-like symptoms, call 911 immediately, as these are sign of carbon monoxide poisoning.

How long does it take to fix a gas leak in an apartment?

Many states will allow a landlord 30 days to fix a problem, while others will only allow three to seven days for serious issues, such as lack of heat or running water.
