2. Rum. Rums, especially ones with alcohol per cent over 60 or so, will burn nicely even if you pour just a little bit on top of your drink.

What whiskey is flammable?

Cognac, rum, or other flavorful liquors that are about 40% alcohol (80 USA proof) are considered ideal for flambé. Wines and beers have too little alcohol and will not flambé. High-alcohol liquors, such as Bacardi 151 or Everclear, are highly flammable and considered too dangerous by professional cooks.

Is Vodka Flammable?

At around 20 percent alcohol by volume, though, it is not as flammable as some other types of alcohol such as rum and grain alcohol. The amount of alcohol content by volume is what determines the flammability rating of alcoholic beverages. Low-alcohol-content beverages such as beer or wine are not considered flammable.


