What three things add up to total stopping distance? Perception Distance + Reaction Distance + Braking Distance.

What are the three parts of total stopping distance?

Total Stopping Distance is the sum of the perception distance, reaction distance and braking distance. Once a driver perceives a need to slow or stop, a small amount of time passes. The time it takes to react and come into the correct braking position is the reaction distance.

What makes up your total stopping distance?

Total stopping distance is made up of three parts: ... The distance your vehicle travels while you react is called a reaction distance. Braking Distance – The distance a vehicle travels from the time a driver begins pressing on the brake pedal until the vehicle comes to a stop.

How do you calculate stopping distance in mph?

Easy Stopping distance formula. As you can see if you start from 20 mph and multiply by 2 then you get the stopping distances for 20 Mph, then for 30 mph multiply by 2.5 and so on, just start at 20 x 2 and go up by half for each additional 10 mph. so 20mph x2, 30mph x 2.5, 40mph x 3 and so on.


How stopping distance is calculated?

Techniques to remember stopping distances All you need to do is multiply the speed by intervals of 0.5, starting with 2. That'll give you the stopping distance in feet, which is acceptable for the theory test. ... There are 3.3 feet in a metre – so divide the distance in feet by 3.3 to get the stopping distance in metres.

What is stopping distance of a vehicle?

Imagine that a car is travelling on a straight road. The driver sees a problem on the road ahead and so brakes suddenly to stop. The stopping distance is the distance that the car travels from the moment that the brakes are applied to the moment that the car stops. This is also called the braking distance.
