## What are the official dimensions of a horseshoe pit?

Pits are constructed 31 to 36 inches wide and 43 to 72 inches deep. If the pit is less than the maximum dimensions, the extra space shall be filled with the same material of which the platforms are made and shall be level with the pit and platforms.

## How deep should the sand be in a horseshoe pit?

Horseshoe Pits need at least four inches of depth and professional pits typically use 8 inches of depth for their pits. **What is the best material for a horseshoe pit?** 

Each properly constructed court should have suitable, well maintained fill material in the "pit" area surrounding the stakes. Actually, any loose or putty-like material will suffice but the most effective material is common blue clay (aka blue shale, soap stone, etc.). Another common material is sand.






