What does Korobeiniki mean?

"Korobeiniki" (Russian: Коробейники, tr. Korobéyniki, IPA: [kərə'biejnʲɪkʲɪ], lit. 'The Peddlers') is a nineteenth-century Russian folk song that tells the story of a meeting between a peddler and a girl, describing their haggling over goods in a metaphor for courtship.

What is the Tetris theme called?

First and foremost, the true name of the Tetris theme is Korobeiniki (the Russian word for peddlers), and it was initially created as a poem by Nikolay Nekrasov in 1861.
