What is the difference between IE and Viz?

—say “i.e.” means simply “that is.” That other scholarly abbreviation, “viz.,” is short for “videlicet” (in Latin videlicet means “it may be seen”). ... In English, the OED says, “videlicet” (and its abbreviation “viz.”) means “that is to say,” “namely,” or “to wit.”

What is a phonetic word?

Phonetic spelling is a system of spelling in which each letter represents one spoken sound. In English, some words are pronounced exactly as they look. When T is used to spell tiger, the letter T is assigned one sound. ... So that single letter (T) does not correlate to only one pronunciation.

What is another word for mixed race?

In English, the terms miscegenation and amalgamation were used for unions between whites, blacks, and other ethnic groups. Those terms are now often considered offensive and are becoming obsolete. The terms mixed-race, biracial or multiracial are becoming generally accepted.

Is the archbishop a Catholic?

Roman Catholic bishops and archbishops are styled "The Most Reverend" and addressed as "Your Excellency" in most cases. In English-speaking countries (except the United States), a Catholic archbishop is addressed as "Your Grace", while a Catholic bishop is addressed as "Your Lordship".

Is scheisse a bad word?

On dict.cc it says Scheiß- translates to crappy, but it adds a note that it's vulgar. In English saying "The weather today is crappy" isn't really offensive (kinda unrefined but not really bad), but saying "The weather today is shitty" would be. I feel Scheiße on its own is pretty rude.

What does SE at the end of a word in Spanish mean?

SE is a pronoun (it can mean him, her, you, himself, herself, or yourself). In Spanish, the pronouns are sometimes stuck on the end of the verb like that. In English that cannot be done.

How do I find my first name?

In America, your “first name” is your personal name, also called your “given name” since it's the name your parents chose to give you rather than the one automatically inherited from your family. In English, your given name usually comes before your family name in everyday speech so it's called your first name.

What does middle finger mean in sign language?

In English, the middle finger is a gesture, as opposed to a word. A gesture is a physical (or verbal) action, like a nod or a head shake or a grunt, that you can't use as a part of a longer sentence. ... In ASL, the middle finger itself still isn't a word, but it's not exactly a gesture either.

'Who I am' is not a question. It isn't even a full sentence - it's part of a question or statement, for example 'I don't know who I am'. In English, a question has to have an interrogative form with the verb before the subject. This is why 'Who I am' cannot be a question.

The simple answer is nothing! In English-speaking countries, it is both common and polite to say “bless you” when someone else sneezes. Chinese speakers, on the other hand, don't often acknowledge other people's sneezes.
