What is the difference between a blini and a pancake?

As nouns the difference between pancake and blini is that pancake is a thin batter cake fried in a pan or on a griddle in oil or butter while blini is a small pancake, of russian origin, made from buckwheat flour; traditionally served with melted butter, sour cream and caviar or smoked salmon.
