NORA. We often think of Nora as a stand-alone name, and that's been true for ages. But Nora probably started out as a short form of names like Eleanor.


Is Eleanor a Scottish name?

Comparatively, it was much less common in Scotland. Elinor, the less common but well established spelling variant, numbering 2126, was more common in Wales.

Eleanor's average ranking is 432.96, with it's highest ever rank being #. Eleanor has reach the top 10 most popular girls name 2 times, and has reached the top hundred names 67 times.
