The short ton (abbreviation: t (US), ST or S/T) is a unit of weight used in the US and equal to 2000 pounds (lbs). The short ton = 0.90718474 metric tons (t) = 907.18474 kilograms (kg). In the United States the short ton is sometimes called simply ton.
