First and foremost, the true name of the Tetris theme is Korobeiniki (the Russian word for peddlers), and it was initially created as a poem by Nikolay Nekrasov in 1861.

#### What does Korobeiniki mean?

"Korobeiniki" (Russian: Коробе́йники, tr. Korobéyniki, IPA: [kereˈbiejniɪkiɪ], lit. 'The Peddlers') is a nineteenth-century Russian folk song that tells the story of a meeting between a peddler and a girl, describing their haggling over goods in a metaphor for courtship.


### Is Korobeiniki copyrighted?

## Where does the Tetris theme song come from?

They settled on an old Russian folk song named "Korobeiniki" (meaning Peddler) which has a much longer history than the game itself. The song was based on a poem from 1861. More importantly, it's famous for its slowly increasing tempo, which fit this stressful puzzle game perfectly.
