What's bad about Cavalier King Charles?

More than most other breeds, Cavalier King Charles Spaniels need a great deal of companionship and do not like being left alone for more than a few hours. They are very dependent dogs – often too dependent. When they feel abandoned, they become anxious, which they express by chewing destructively and barking.

Neurologic Problems. Several neurologic diseases can afflict Cavalier King Charles Spaniels. Symptoms of neurological problems can include seizures, imbalance, tremors, weakness, or excess sleeping. If you notice any of these symptoms, please seek immediate veterinary care.

How Long Can dogs live with syringomyelia?

However 43% of the group survived to be greater than 9 years of age (average life expectancy for a CKCS is 10.7 years). Most dogs retain the ability to walk although some may be significantly tetraparetic and ataxic.

Are King Charles Spaniels good for allergy sufferers?

The Cavalier King Charles Spaniel are not a hypoallergenic dog breed. However, these dogs can be mixed with some other breeds to create a pup that is better suited to those with a dog allergy.
