### Who invented the pizza?

An often recounted story holds that on June 11, 1889, to honour the Queen consort of Italy, Margherita of Savoy, the Neapolitan pizzamaker [Raffaele Esposito](#) created the "[Pizza Margherita](#)", a pizza garnished with tomatoes, mozzarella, and basil, to represent the national colours of Italy as on the Flag of Italy.

#### Who is the Inventor of the Pizza?

The Origins of Pizza. Food historians agree that pizza-like dishes (i.e. flatbreads with oils, spices, and other toppings) were eaten by many peoples in the Mediterranean, including the ancient Greeks and Egyptians. When writing a history of Rome in the third century BCE, Cato the Elder described pizza-like rounds of bread topped with olives and herbs.

#### Who Invented Pizza?

Who invented pizza? Like so many questions regarding the invention of objects, this question is more difficult to answer than it would first appear. From what historians know, while people have been eating pizza-like foods for a fair number of centuries, what we currently think of as pizza was created less than 200 years ago, allegedly created by Raffaele Esposito around 1889.

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#### Who really invented pizza?

Specifically, baker Raffaele Esposito from Naples is often given credit for making the first such pizza pie. Historians note, however, that street vendors in Naples sold flatbreads with toppings for many years before then. Legend has it that Italian King Umberto I and Queen Margherita visited Naples in 1889.

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#### When and how was pizza invented?

Italians Didn't Invent Pizza However, since Naples, Italy was founded as a Green port city, pizza was developed further in Italy. At first, it was bread with oil and herbs. It wasn't until later that mozzarella and tomatoes were added. The modern pizza, as we know it today, became popular in the late 18th century.

#### Did the Chinese invent pizza?

Italians developed and perfected their style of pizza making, but they were not the only culture that appreciated the ease and deliciousness of the dish. Some people even credit the Chinese with the invention, but the Greeks (and others) also had a role. The Greeks baked a flatbread known as plakous in mud ovens.
