On 19 April 1989, the Number Two 16-inch gun turret of the United States Navy battleship USS Iowa (BB-61) exploded. The explosion in the center gun room killed 47 of the turret's crewmen and severely damaged the gun turret itself.

The US Department of Defense (DoD) has released its '2020 China Military Power Report' showing that the People's Republic of China (PRC) has the largest navy in the world, surpassing the US Navy.

How many ships are in the Chinese Navy?
