Why does God only answer some prayers?

God does not answer some prayers because he knows everything and we do not. ... But what we do know is that God loves us, cares for us, and hears our prayers. Thus whatever the outcome, we can be certain that God has our best interest at heart. We do not always know what we are really asking for, but God always does.

Why does God seem to answer some prayers and not others?

If we find that God doesn't answer our prayers in the way that we are hoping for, then we can take that as an opportunity to come into rest. This can be an active battle, because it means giving up my own will and reconciling myself to God's plan for my life.

Does God answer prayers?

Does God answer prayers? – When God says "no." In John 11, Mary and Martha wanted Jesus to heal their dying brother, yet Jesus allowed Lazarus to die. Why did He say "no" to these grieving women who loved Him so much? Because He had greater things planned for Lazarus, things that no one could possibly have imagined.

Does God Answer All Your Prayers?

This is the heart of what prayer is all about. It is not just about asking for things; it is about seeking God's face and enjoying 'sweet communion with him'. This is the context of David's request. He cried out to God for help in the face of his enemies (vv.13–14). God heard and answered his prayers with a positive response, 'Yes'.

Why does God only answer some people's prayers?

Originally Answered: Why does God answer only some people's prayers? It's the random nature of chance. If enough people ask for enough things enough times, some of the things for which prayers are said will actually happen.

Why isn't God answering my prayers even though I live for Him?

When we pray, God answers our prayers in the way that is best for us. He loves us. This means He wants our good, and He knows that our ultimate good is to be united with Him. We may not understand how His answers accomplish this, just as He taught Job, but that is why He is God and we are not. All we need to do is trust Him.

This is an encouragement, but also a command. At a fundamental level then, prayer is a matter of obedience. The Word of God commands us to pray. We must strive to become people of prayer.


What does it mean to be in constant prayer?
